This was the decadent and deadly world of Kate Leigh and Tilly Devine – two legendary vice queens bound by their hatred for each other.

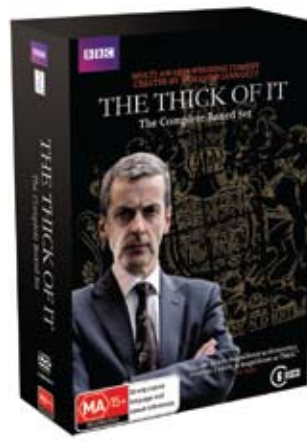
Kate and Tilly reigned over rival empires built on gambling, prostitution, drugs, extortion and murder.

The Thick of It

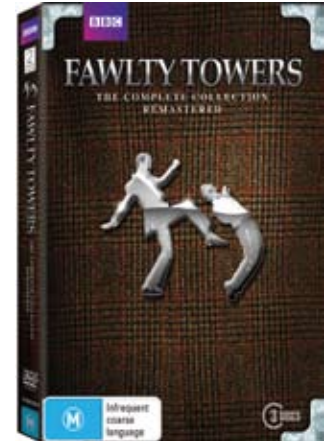
